3. Complete a resume that includes how you have been involved in department, university, and community activities.
4. Return all of the above to the Criminal Justice Sciences Department, Schroeder Hall 441, by **Friday March 24, 2006**. This award will be presented at the Annual CJS Student Awards Reception, Tuesday, April 18, 2006.
